Sea-Tac Airport Overview

Economic Impact

- Over 150,000 jobs (87,300 direct) supported by airport
- \$442 million in state and local taxes
- \$7.4 billion direct impact to airport-area cities
- 1,953 jobs were filled in 2017 through Airport Jobs


